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Tile: Valley Series, color beige/blue/grey "VA-636" Peacock porcelain body glazed.

Nominal size: 6" x 6" x 1/4". Tile made in China.

Conditions: New tiles sent to TILE INSTITUTE of AMERICA in sealed manufacturer's boxes from client above and selected at random.

ANSI 137.1 CRAZING TEST (ASTM C 424)

Procedure:

Ten (10) tile samples were placed in an autoclave using distilled water. The steam pressure was raised to 150 PSI as specified, and retained for 1 hour before turning off the heat source and releasing the steam pressure immediately by opening the blow-off valve. The samples were cooled down, removed and inspected using an ink solution applied to the glazed surface. Results are as follow:

Observation of Tile

One 150 PSI All ten samples show No Evidence of Crazing

Requirement: Using 150 PSI steam pressure for one cycle the tile shall show no evidence of crazing.

Test Results: Pass
